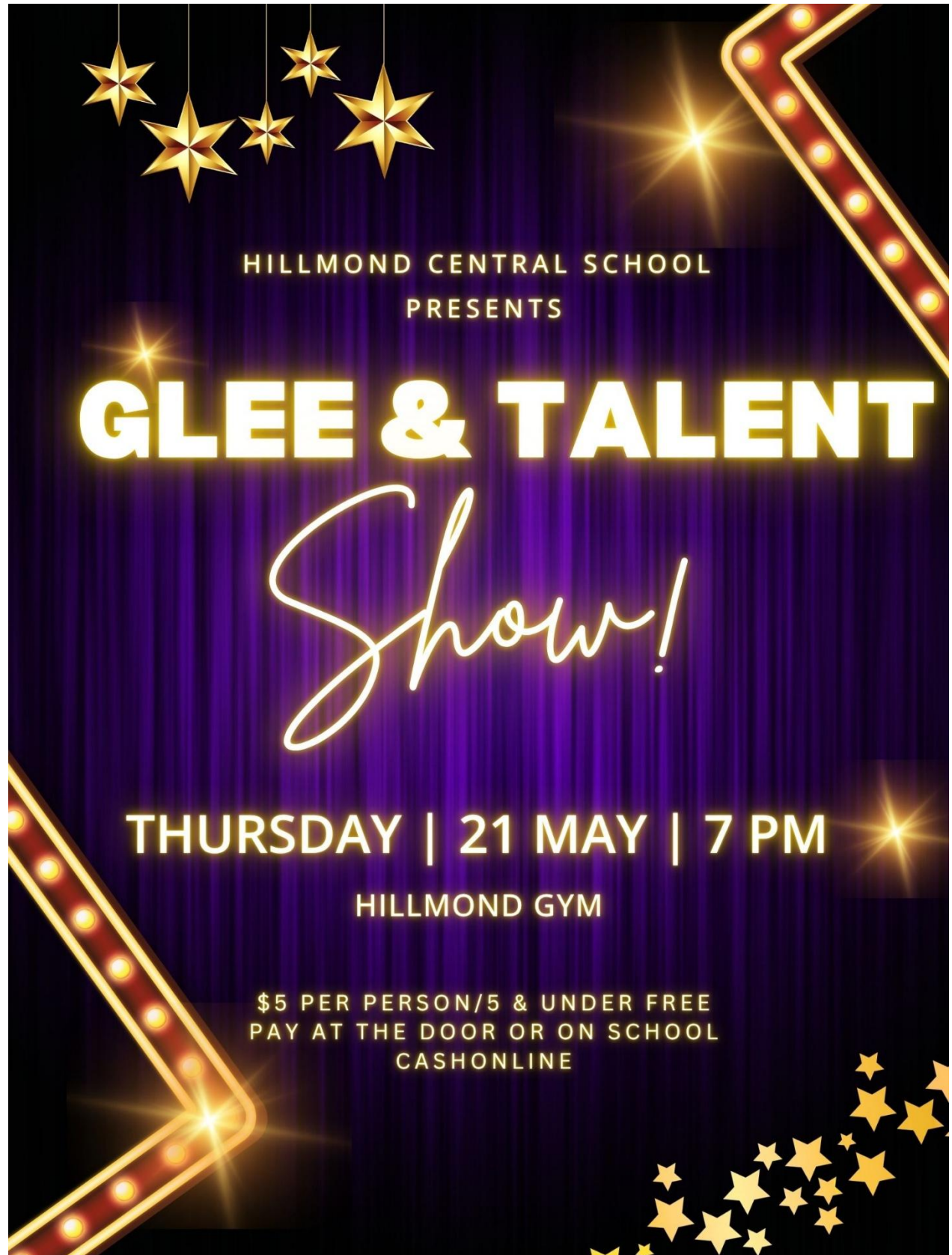

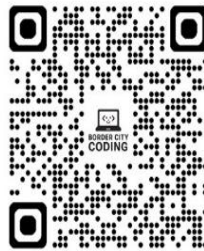

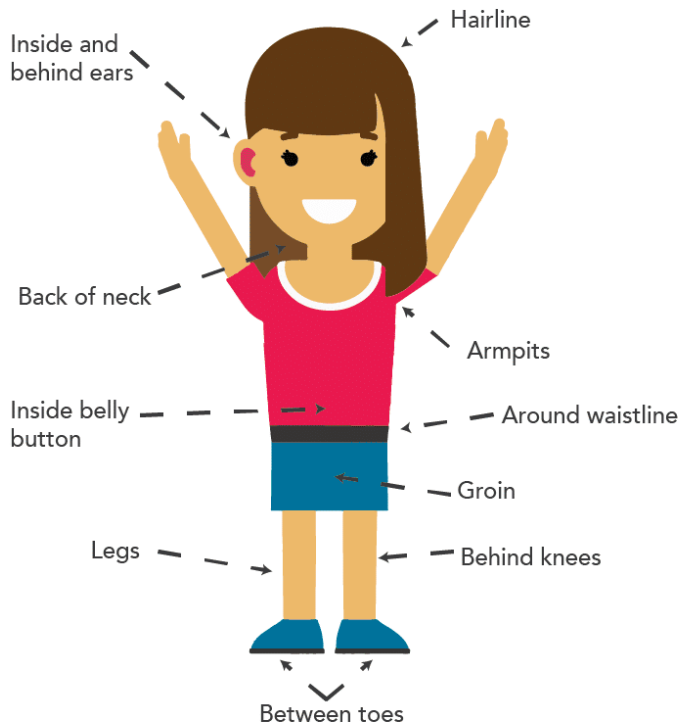
# Ticks



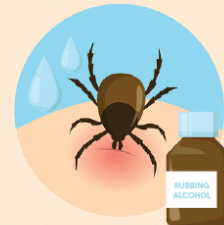
## Key Facts:

- Ticks can spread disease among animals and humans.

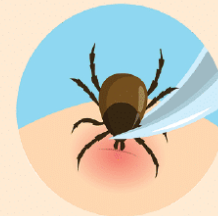
## Where to Check for Ticks



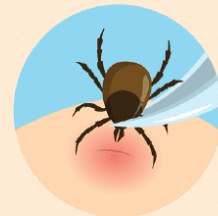
## HOW TO REMOVE A TICK



Sanitize bite area and tweezers with alcohol



Grab tick close to head



Pull up slowly and carefully



Sanitize bite area again
